SIMPLE POEMS AND RHYMES ARE EXCELLENT FOR IMPROVING PHONEMIC AWARENESS AND UNDERSTANDING RHYTHM AND LANGUAGE PATTERNS.

HOW TO USE COMPREHENSION PASSAGES FOR GRADE 3 WITH QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

TO MAXIMIZE THE BENEFITS OF COMPREHENSION PRACTICE, PARENTS AND TEACHERS CAN FOLLOW THESE TIPS:

READ ALOUD AND DISCUSS

READING THE PASSAGE ALOUD TO THE CHILD ENCOURAGES ENGAGEMENT AND ALLOWS YOU TO MODEL FLUENT READING. PAUSE TO ASK OPEN-ENDED QUESTIONS THAT SPARK DISCUSSION AND ENCOURAGE PREDICTIONS.

USE VARIED QUESTION TYPES

MIX LITERAL QUESTIONS (WHO, WHAT, WHERE) WITH INFERENTIAL AND EVALUATIVE ONES TO CHALLENGE COMPREHENSION AND CRITICAL THINKING.

1. MIA WAS PLAYING IN HER BACKYARD.
2. MIA HEARD A SOFT WHIMPERING SOUND.
3. THE PUPPY LOOKED SCARED AND WAS TREMBLING.
4. MIA DECIDED TO TAKE CARE OF THE PUPPY UNTIL SHE COULD FIND ITS OWNER.
5. THE PUPPY WAS PROBABLY HIDING BECAUSE IT WAS SCARED AND LOST.

THIS EXAMPLE USES SIMPLE LANGUAGE AND RELATABLE CONTENT SUITABLE FOR THIRD GRADERS WHILE ENCOURAGING THEM TO THINK BEYOND THE TEXT.
