At its root, the ecological crisis is a theological crisis, not only in the way that humans regard creation and their place in it, but in the way that humans think about God. For Pope Francis in *Laudato Si'*, the root of the crisis is that we humans have tried to put ourselves in God's place. According to Pope Francis, therefore, A fragile world, entrusted by God to human care, challenges us to devise intelligent ways of directing, developing, and limiting our power.

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
